Making a Difference is an interfaith workshop for clergy and those involved in ministry. It will challenge you to rethink what is possible for yourself and for your ministry, and it will provide you with the tools to successfully bring about a future that is a match for your vision and commitment. Participants can expect a consistent and broad range of breakthrough results in both the spiritual and practical aspects of ministry. The most commonly reported outcomes are:

- Greater clarity about your purpose and the direction of your ministry as well as your personal life, so that each is a source of nourishment for the other.
- A richer and deeper prayer life, leaving you more centered and with a greater experience of serenity.
- The ability to move beyond limitations of thinking and acting and move into a future based on something more than what is predictable from the past.
- Valuable, new tools for affecting significant change, including a new and more powerful use of language.
- The ability to communicate in a powerful way that inspires and calls forth the alignment, cooperation, and partnership of others.
- Renewal and deepening of faith along with a new appreciation and respect for the faith and traditions ofothers.
- An appreciation and expansion of your natural charisma and capacity for leadership, including a greater confidence, a greater experience of your own worth, and the difference you can make.
